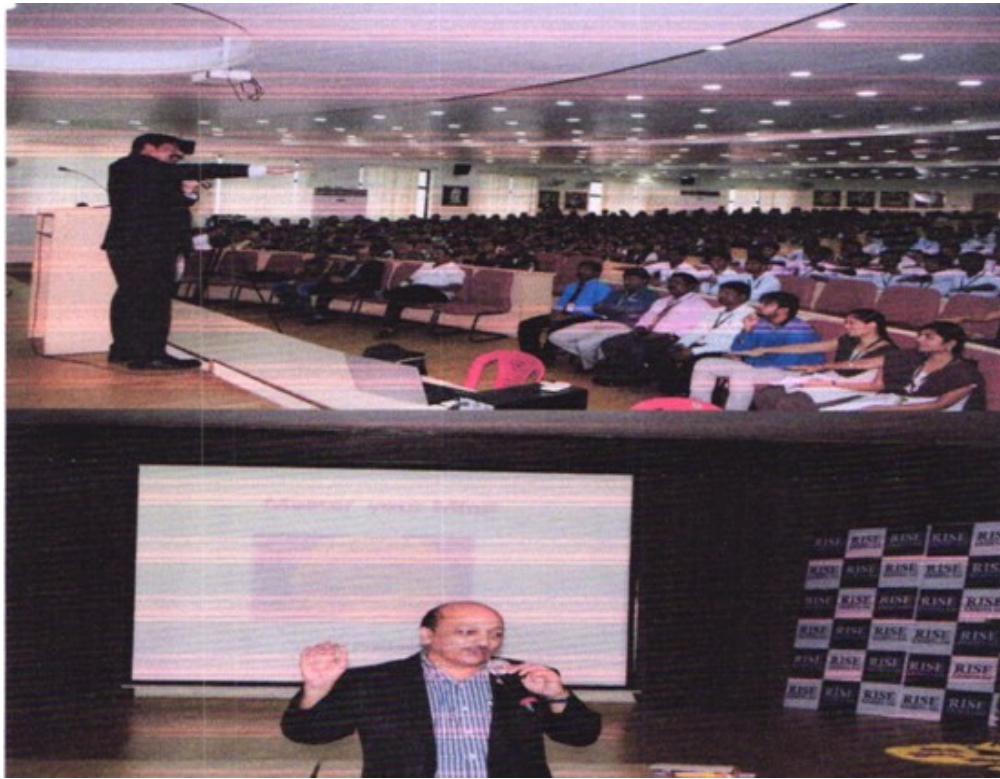

Gampa Nageswara Rao founded IMPACT Free Training for Unemployed Youth in 1996, and over a million youth have benefitted from it. This Program Is Being Organized with The Goal of Providing Quality Training On Skills That Are Extremely crucial In Today's Scenario, Particularly On Soft Skills To The Youth, Specifically, Students And Unemployed Young People Will Empower Them To Face The Needs Of The Modern Employment Sector Effectively And Thus Rise As Winners In Society.

Since 1996, more than 2500 Telugu trainers have educated as young soft skills trainers for free, and over a million youth have benefitted from it. Free career counseling sessions were held in various districts of Andhra Pradesh/Telangana and throughout the world. Through their speech, they have rescued many youths from attempting suicide. They have assisted thousands of young people with motivating videos on Facebook.

**Garikipati Narasimha Rao** is an Indian scholar, litterateur, and [avadhani](#) from [Andhra Pradesh](#).<sup>[2][3]</sup> In 1996, he performed Avadhanam with 1116 *Pruchchakas* for 21 days in [Kakinada](#). He also delivers lectures on personality development based on [dharmic](#) culture and way of life. He regularly appears on Telugu TV channels like [SVBC](#), [Bhakti TV](#), and [ABN Andhra Jyothi](#) giving discourses on ancient [Hindu](#) texts like [Bhagavadgita](#), [Ramayana](#), and [Mahabharata](#). In 2022, he was awarded India's fourth-highest [civilian award Padma Shri](#) by the [government of India](#).

Rao started performing Avadhanams in the year 1972. Avadhanis are respected for their abilities to spin out verses conforming to Telugu grammar on literally any subject that audience may throw at them, as a challenge. He has conducted more than 288 avadhanams, including Dvigunita Avadhanam at Dallas for the American Telugu Association in 2002. Rao is known for his Dhāraṇā (memorising and reciting), which is a key requirement for performing Avadhanams.

On 26 November 2018, while at Koti Deepotsavam Stage, Rao emotionally announced that very soon he will retire from discoursing pravachanams and public speeches after completing already accepted projects, in order to attain inner peace and enlightenment but later he changed his decision per public requests and to help and activate the society through his way of speeches.

**Suddala Ashok Teja** (born **Gurram Ashok Teja**; 4 April 1954) is an Indian poet and lyricist known for his work in [Telugu cinema](#) and [Telugu literature](#).<sup>[3]</sup> He has written lyrics for over 2200 songs. He won the [National Film Award for Best Lyrics](#) for the song "Nenu saitam" from *Tagore* (2004).

Ashok Teja worked as a government teacher in Bandalingapur, Medipally and Metpally villages of [Karimnagar district](#) before coming into the Telugu film industry. He started writing lyrics ever since he was a child. His nephew Uttej a well known character artiste in [Telugu films](#) helped him to get a first chance in films. He became popular after penning the lyrics for the films *Osey Ramulamma* and *Ninne Pelladutha* during the years 1996–1997.

He won the [National Film Award for Best Lyrics](#) in the year 2003 for his song *Nenu Saitham* in the movie *Tagore* (2003), it is based on [Sri Sri](#)'s 'Nenu Saitham' from *Mahaprasthanam*. He is the third writer to win this award after [Sri Sri](#) for his "Telugu veera levara" in *Alluri Sitaramaraju* and [Veturi](#) for his "Raalipoye puvva neeku ragaalenduke" in "Matrudevobhava". He wrote over 2200 songs for 1250 movies and 2500 private songs till 2017. He won [SIIMA Award for Best Lyricist \(Telugu\)](#) in 2018 for *Vachinde* song from *Fidaa* (2017).
